February Visit Highlights

In February, I ministered in two prominent churches—in Be'er Sheva and Tel Aviv. I also visited several rehabilitation centers, where we witnessed the power of the Gospel to heal and restore broken lives.

April Visit Highlights

In April, I ministered in seven churches and several rehab centers across the country. The response was **overwhelming**—leaders welcomed me with open arms, many inviting me to return for future collaboration. Each visit brought new divine connections—pastors, leaders, and believers with a deep hunger for truth. From Samaria to the Negev, **God is stirring hearts**, especially among the Jewish people. Our teams in Wales and Israel continue to seek the Lord together, discerning every step with prayer and sensitivity. It is both an honor and a holy responsibility to carry this message to Israel. City of Hope Rehab: Several surrendered their lives to Jesus.

Tel Aviv: Preached at one of Israel’s oldest Hebrew-speaking churches (founded in 1860)—a beautiful hunger for restoration was evident.
